



2012 MSA British Rally Championship Information Sheet No. 1

1. CHAMPIONSHIP STEWARDS

Article 3.4, the Championship Stewards are Nicky Moffitt, Tony Newsum and Richard Bargery.

2. CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS

Article 48.3.7 - Add Ravenol BRC Privateers Cup – Open to registered drivers who are not nominated as a team representative on events. The point scoring system 5.3 and 5.6.1 will be used.

3. SEALING OF MECHANICAL COMPONENTS

Articles 51.3 to 51.7 of the Championship Regulations refers.

The Championship Technical Delegate will issue each competitor (appointed team representative) with their Vehicle Passport and the relevant championship seals at scrutineering. Competitors must ensure that these seals are attached appropriately and are presented in place for subsequent inspection by the scrutineers.

Advice and guidance will be available for those competitors and teams that are unsure of the procedures.

4. CEREMONIAL STARTS, AUTOGRAPH SIGNING AND PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES

Article 65 of the Championship Regulations refers.

The Championship will endeavour to provide registered competitors with all relevant information prior to each round/promotional opportunities and activity.

5. PIRELLI TYRE ORDERING PROCESS

For 2012, Pirelli Tyres UK have appointed Wheeltech as their agent, jointly they will administer, supply and fit all control tyres for the 2012 MSA British Rally Championship.

Competitors must pre-order any tyres.

Order forms can be downloaded from the BRC website www.rallybrc.co.uk (Competitors Section). Contact details are available on the order form.

The 2012 control tyre sizes and compounds on gravel rounds are listed below:

Size	Compound
165/70.15	K6
175/70.15	K6
195/70.15	K6

Competitors and teams are requested to give consideration to the operation of the fitment of tyres prior and during each rally. To this end Wheeltech will be present on each event the day prior to the day of scrutineering and you are respectfully requested to make contact with them ahead of the event to arrange your tyre supply and early fitment. *The Championship will endeavour to provide each registered competitor with details of opening times for the fitment of tyres.*

6. TYRE NOMINATIONS

Tyre Nominations for Rallye Sunseeker International will close at 17.30hrs on Friday 24th February.

7. SUNOCO CONTROL FUEL ORDERING PROCESS

There are two grades of Control Fuel available from the official supplier, Sunoco Race Fuels, for the 2012 MSA British Rally Championship, a motorsport blended fuel from Sunoco and a petrol forecourt fuel. Specification of these fuels have been published on the BRC website in the Competitors documents section.

Fuel must be ordered in advance of each event and paid for using your credit card prior to signing on for each rally.

During the order process you must specify which fuel and the amount you need for the rally. If you don't use the amount you have requested then your account will be credited for the next event. Please ensure that you have ordered sufficient for each car, as there will be no payments taken over the duration of the rally.

At each event, competitors will be issued with a colour coded decal which will identify the type of fuel that has been ordered. These decals need to be placed on the corner of the roof above the windscreen on the co-drivers side of the car.

CONTROL FUEL DELIVERY

Fuel will be available at the BRC refuel zone at each event. As a rule the site will be set-up and dispense fuel from the time scrutineering opens until the end of the rally. *The Championship will endeavour to provide registered competitors with information providing periods when the refuel zone will be open.*

Competitors are reminded of their responsibilities and the procedures to be carried out in a refuel zone under FIA regulations and it's the competitor's responsibility to ensure that equipment is stowed; boot and bonnet are secured after these operations have been carried out.

CONTROL FUEL SAMPLING AND TESTING

Fuel samples will be taken from selected cars at any time throughout the duration of the event by the Championship. We would recommend that competitors and their teams become conversant with the method and operation. See BRC Regulation Articles 21.4.3 & 21.4.4

At each test, the sample taken will be divided into three containers. These samples will be labelled and sealed. One sample is given to the competitor, one held by the Championship Technical Delegate and the third sent away for testing.

The testing process will take place away from the event and results of the test will be published at a later date. If a non compliant test result is found the Championship shall apply the necessary penalty to the competitor and make public the results of the infringement.

The scrutineers in charge of the testing procedures will make every effort to give guidance and best advice to competitors who are new to these procedures.

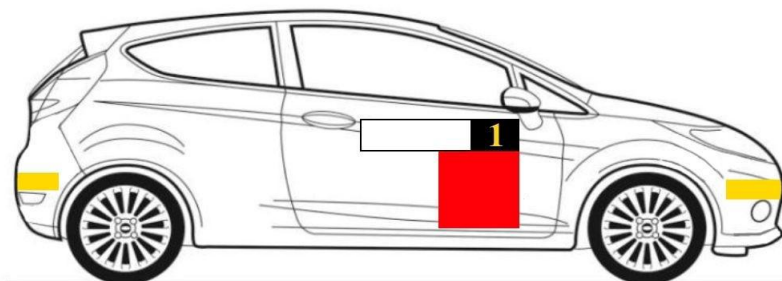
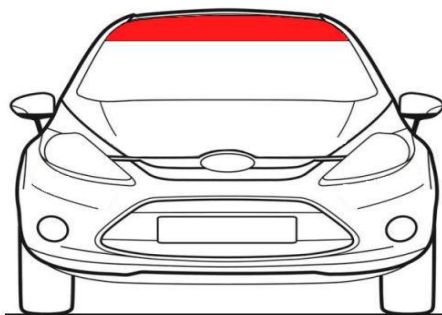
8. CLOTH BADGES

Article 67.1 of the Championship Regulations refers:

All registered competitors must wear a Pirelli cloth badge, which will be supplied by the Championship on their race suit on the right breast of their race suit. The BRC cloth badge will not be utilised at this time, but may be added later.

9. CHAMPIONSHIP DECALS

Your attention is drawn to Articles 67.2, 67.3 and 67.4 of the Championship Regulations regarding the placement of Championship windscreen decal, Championship sponsors door panel and Official Tyre Supplier decals.



The windscreen header is provided with a "white" witness mark in the centre near the top of the decal. This should be positioned on the top centreline of the windscreen, this ensures that there is sufficient overlap available for trimming at the corners of the screen.

No other decal/branding is permitted on the windscreen header area.

Article 67.2, the requirement to have Championship decals for the event shakedown will be relaxed on the first round, Rallye Sunseeker International.
